Common Misconceptions About FC Milwaukee

They Practice More. FC Milwaukee Juniors will practice 1-2 times per week depending on age level.

FC Milwaukee will provide significant coaching education, resources and assistance to all FC Milwaukee Juniors coaches.

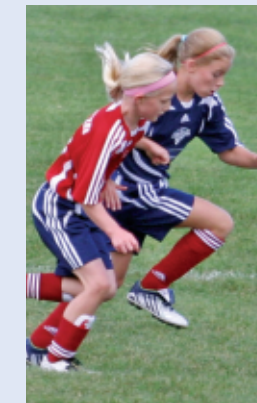
Practices:

Conducted in Menomonee Falls.

1-2 times per week.

60-90 minute sessions depending on team and coach.
